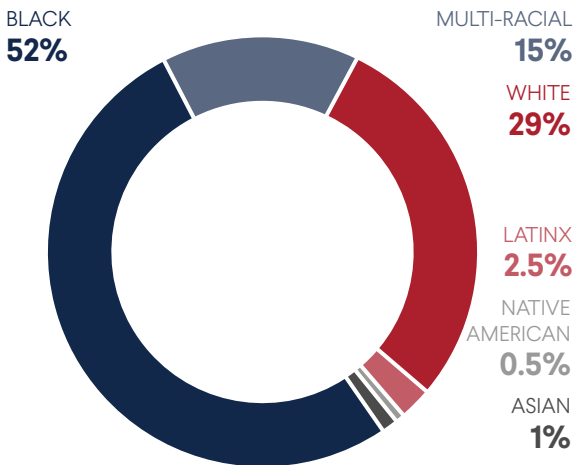

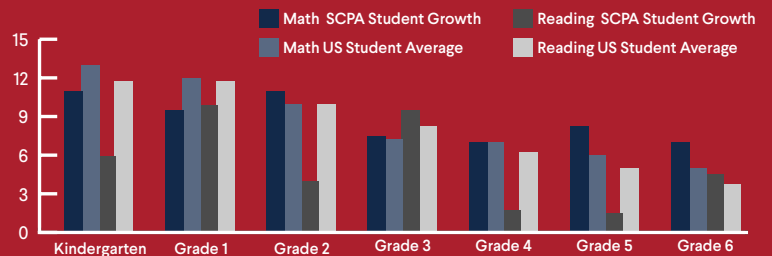

## SPONSOR STATEMENT
