



DRESS CODE

SHIRTS

Students are required to wear school uniform daily. Shirts (no sleeveless) must be solid white, grey, red, or blue (light, dark, or “true”).

Shirts must have a collar or turtleneck, logos no larger than a quarter, and may be polo or oxford style. Shirts should remain tucked during the school day for student and teacher safety.



PANTS/SHORTS, JUMPERS/SKIRTS/SKORTS

Pants, shorts, and capri's must be solid khaki, black, grey, or navy in color.

The following items will **not** be allowed: jean material, cargo pocket pants, leggings, fad fabrics, spandex, lycra, leather, wet look, mesh, sheer, metallic, fishnet, frayed hems, stripes, “lace up” on ankles or waist pants (drawstring waist is okay).



■■■■■■■■■■ skirts, skorts, or jumpers in navy or khaki. ■■■■■■■■■■ leggings, stockings or knee-highs should all be one color of white, blue, or black. No designs please.

Shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers and shorts must not be any shorter than 1-inch above the knee.

SHOES

Closed-toe shoes (tennis shoes, flats, boots, etc.) will be allowed. All shoes must cover the toes and heels. Students may not be allowed to wear sandals, Crocs, flip-flops, or slippers.

Should the student come to school in attire outside of these requirements we will:
